

University City High School PTSA Board presents: 20-hour SAT Test Preparation at the University of San Diego

University of San Diego and The UCHS PTSA Board have collaborated to create a unique SAT Preparation course. This course will be available only to UCHS students. The cost per student is \$250 for a 20-hour course that includes 16 hours of lessons and strategies as well as a 4-hour practice test. This represents a discount of over 50% off a typical USD prep course.

Class Details:

WHAT: 20-hour SAT Preparation Course

WHERE: Class will be held on University of San Diego Campus

WHEN: Saturday Mornings from 8:30am – 12:30pm

DATES: Oct. 6, Oct. 13, Oct. 20, Oct. 27, Nov. 3

COST: \$250 per student – includes all study materials

CLASS SIZE: Space is limited! A wait list will be started after the maximum of 30 students has been reached.

ADDITIONAL BENEFIT: Students will receive detailed individual score reports for their practice test and all materials are theirs to keep for continued self-practice.
